








#### **EU Partnership Agriculture of Data**

- Research projects & use cases







#### Call scope & topics

- Topic 1 data technolgies and data management focused on identification, access, storage, integration and processing of FAIR data, tackling the diversity of relevant data to achieve:
  - Interoperatility,
  - Data sharing,
  - Enable application of AI techniques to develop robust AI models for the sector
- Topic 2 Data-based solutions for sustainable agriculture intended to strengthen capacities to adapt to climate change, enhancing functionality, performance assessment and decision making
- Topic 3 Data-based solutions for policy-making to provide reliable indicators that reflect effects of policies, in particular the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP), and development of tools to strengthen policy performance assessemnt, by means of data gathering and analytical capabilities.














#### Who can apply?

- Funding mechanism:
  - Direct funding from national Funding Organisation
  - EU co-funding
  - !! Highly recommended to contact your national Funder before preparing a proposal!!
  - Some funders may require contact before submission
- Check your national Funders' requirements! >> AgData call1
   Call Announcement & Funder Regulations
- Eligible applicants depending on the National Regulation
  - Universities; Research Institutes
  - Non-profit Organisations
  - Private companies
  - Civil society representatives; consumers/citizens







## **Eligibility Criteria (I)**

#### Consortium Requirements

• Minimum 3 eligible partners from 3 different Funding countries:

Belgium	Denmark	Estonia	Finland	France	Germany	Hungary	Ireland	Israel
Italy	Latvia	The Netherlands		Portugal	Romania	Slovakia	Spain	Türkiye

- Recommended maximum: 10 partners
- Balanced consortia: max 60% total person months with one partner
- Associated partners:
  - Do not count to the minimum partner number
  - Do not request & recieve funding
  - Have to provide a Letter of Committment at Short proposal phase






# **Eligibility Criteria (II)**

#### Submission requirements

- Online submission AgData call1
- In English
- Short proposal submission until 21<sup>st</sup>
   January 2026 noon (CET)
- Full proposal submssion until 21<sup>st</sup> July 2026 noon (CEST)
- Completeness (recommendation: check, Validation' to find missing information)
  - Information from ALL partners



# **Eligibility Criteria (III)**

- Eligibility Check:
  - Failure to meet any criteria leads to rejection of proposal
  - e.g. associated partner without Letter of Commitment leads to rejection of the whole proposal
- Double check what documents are requested for each national eligibility:
  - Align to national priorities
  - Maximum amount of resources available for each partner in a country
  - Specific administrative rules
  - Specific requirements for partners eligibility
- If only one partner from your consortium is not eligible at national level > the entire consortium will be considered ineligible





# Coordination & Submission (I)

#### Coordinator has to:

- Confirm national regulations and funding modalities with all partners
- Guarantee eligibility of the entire project throughout the application procedure
- Create account on the online submission platform
- Submit pre-proposal and full proposal
- Be central contact point for the consortium
- Be responsible for project coordination throughout its lifespan
- Inform about events affecting project implementation
- Meet contractually bound deliverables and milestones
- Disseminate all relevant information to consortium partners
- Monitor data & ensure timely delivery of project reports
  - Mid-term & End-term reporting of follow-up activities
  - Plan potential reporting meeting in the budget








# **Coordination & Submission (III)**

- Information needed for Short proposal:
  - Per partner:
    - Partner Information
    - Privacy policy
    - CV
    - Letter of Commitment (only Associated partners)
    - Financial plan, financial comments (partners requesting funding)
  - Per consortium (provided by Coordinator):
    - Project data, keywords
    - Project summary, C-R&I-A selection justification
    - State of the art (4000 characters); Project description (10000 characters)
    - Short description of planned use case(s)
    - Financial plan, financial comments
    - Letter of Commitment (only Associated partners)

## Coordination & Submission (IV)

- Submission
  - Only complete proposals can be submitted- use Validation tab to find missing information
  - Before deadline: submission as many time as needed (new submission replaces old one)
  - Submit Early to avoid last-minute technical problems
  - Close to the deadline high traffic is expected
    - Deadline short proposal: 21<sup>st</sup> January 2026, noon (CET)
    - Deadline full proposal: 21<sup>st</sup> July 2026, noon (CEST)
  - Coordinator's Role: Responsible for timely submission via the online system







# Coordination & Submission (V)

- Only consortia invited to submit Full proposals
- Additional Information needed for Full proposals
  - Per consortium (provided by Coordinator):
    - Project description (20000 characters)
    - Workplan (incl. Gantt chart)
    - Data Management Plan
    - Communication, Dissemination and Exploitation Plan
    - Ethical Compliance
  - Templates for the new sections will be made available on the submission website upon full proposal stage opening (22<sup>nd</sup> May 2026)



#### **Evaluation & Selection (I)**

- After submission (short proposal & full proposal):
  - Call Office & national funders check eligibility
  - Non-eligible proposals will be rejected
  - Communication: Eligibility check results communicated before evaluation phase
- After Eligibility check:
  - Expert evaluation > communication of scores to coordinators
  - Redress period
- Based on expert evaluation
  - Funders Board selection for inviting full proposal submissions / funding of projects






# **Evaluation & Selection (II)**

- Evaluation Panel (IEP) Mandate
  - Responsibilities:
    - Peer review proposals based on defined criteria
    - Provide a written summary for FB and for applicants sent by the Call Office
    - Propose a ranking list of proposals based on scores
  - Committee Structure:
    - Chair & Members: Independent of Funding Parties and applicants, balanced
    - Conflict of Interest:
      - IEP members sign Conflict of Interest and Declaration of Confidentiality forms
      - Online tool prevents access to conflicted proposals

- Strict Confidentiality
  - Applicant identities
  - Proposal content
  - Access restricted to FB, IEP, and Call Office
  - Data handled per GDPR
- Evaluation Process
  - at least three international experts will evaluate each proposal
  - Consensus scores determined in meetings

# **Evaluation & Selection (III)**

#### Evaluation Criteria

#### • Excellence:

 Clarity of objectives, soundness of concept, methodology credibility, consortium quality, innovation, interdisciplinary approaches

#### • Impact:

Relevance to Call scope and topics, project impact potential

#### Quality and Efficiency of Implementation:

- (only full proposal)
- Work plan quality, management structure, participant complementarity, task allocation, project budget appropriateness

#### Scoring - Scale: 0 to 5 (no half scores in FP)

- 0: Fails to address criterion
- 1: Poor
- 2: Fair
- 3: Good
- 4: Very Good
- 5: Excellent

#### Thresholds:

- Criteria score < 4/5 (SP) or < 3/5 (FP):</li>
   Not recommended for funding
- Total score of < 8 (SP) or < 10 (FP):</li>
   Not proposed for funding





#### **Evaluation & Selection (IV)**

- Outcome: Proposals ranked by final scores
- Final Decision:
  - Made by FB based on ranking and available funding
  - Communicated by the Call Office to the project coordinators (Evaluation summaries will be provided to the coordinators which are responsible for forwarding all information to the proposal partners.)
  - Funded projects list published





#### **Evaluation & Selection (V)**

- Ethics Evaluation Procedure
  - Two-Step Process
    - Step 1: Ethics Screening
    - Outcomes: Full Clearance, Conditional Clearance, Ethics Assessment
    - Step 2: Ethics Assessment
      - In-depth analysis
    - Outcomes: Full Clearance, Conditional Clearance, No Ethics Clearance
- General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)
  - Data Handling
  - Compliance: GDPR Regulation EU 679/2016
- Privacy Policy: Available on submission website





#### Obligations for funded projects (I)

- Contract Negotiation
  - Notification letter received
  - Contact Funding Parties for grant negotiation
- Funding:
  - Provided per national regulations
  - Possible need for Consortium Agreement
- Communication, Dissemination, and Exploitation
  - Up to 2-page CDE Plan
  - Reference to Agriculture of Data in project-related information





#### Obligations for funded projects (II)

- Project Monitoring and Meetings
  - Mid-term and end-term status reports
  - Participation in mandatory joint meetings (kick-off, mid-term, end-term)
- Data Management
  - Up to 2-page Data Management Plan in proposal
  - Updated plan as deliverable within first six months
- Ethics Assessment
  - Compliance:
    - Appropriate authorization for human/animal work
    - Address potential ethical issues in proposal
    - Follow EU guidelines for non-EU activities

#### Redress

- Applicants can challenge the eligibility check and evaluation outcome only, if they suspect a breach in the application/implementation of the procedures.
- This redress procedure only covers the procedural aspects of the evaluation and/or eligibility checks, including the national eligibility checks.
- The redress will not question the scientific or technical judgement of appropriately qualified experts.
- The request for redress must demonstrate a procedural irregularity, factual error, manifest error of assessment, misuse of power, or a conflict of interest.
- Requests for redress that ..... express mere disagreement with the result or the reasoning of the evaluation will be judged as not suitable for redress.
